Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know, the Year 6 visit to Kingswood is fast approaching (21st-25<sup>th</sup> May 2018) so we have included a list of what the children should have with them for the residential visit.

Please use the following checklist to help pack bags:

(Put your child's name on all items of clothing)

- One swimming towel and costume
- One bath towel
- Toiletries bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc
- Night clothes (warm pyjamas as it gets cold in the evenings)
- Socks and underwear
- Four t-shirts, shirts, blouses (at least one with long-sleeves), sweatshirt
- One thick sweater plus one light sweater
- Three pairs of trousers and/or jeans and/or tracksuit bottoms
- Clothes for the evening activities
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Sturdy shoes or wellingtons (even in summer)
- Two pairs of trainers (one old pair)
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Gloves, hat, scarf (in winter)
- Water bottle- this is really important!
- Hat and sunscreen (in spring and summer)
- Indoor shoes- the children are not allowed to wear their trainers in the tents
- Medication- this should be clearly labelled and given to your child's class teacher

\*Please note that most activities require long sleeves.

Do not bring: Mobile phones, expensive cameras, electronic games, tablets, expensive or much cherished jewellery, expensive favourite clothing or shoes. Kingswood can't accept liability for the loss, theft or damage of any personal property your child may bring and they will be confiscated. All food is provided; therefore children must not bring any drinks or snacks with them as it will attract wildlife!

We know that you'll have questions about the upcoming visit, so we will be holding a meeting for parents and carers on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> March at 3:45 in the hall. We hope to see you there.
