Dear Parent/Carers,

Beginning next week Parkhill Junior School will be participating in the Big Pedal (23 April to 4 May 2018). Lasting two weeks, the children will have a chance to take part in a range of activities related to cycling. It is an excellent way to get more of our pupils travelling to school on their bikes and scooters. Each week there will be prizes that can be won by children who have cycled or scooted to school. In addition to this, we will be competing to become one of the UK's top schools for two-wheeled journeys and will be in with a chance to win prizes including bike and scooter stunt shows, exciting days out and fantastic cycle and scooter storage.

To encourage children to cycle to school we will be holding a 'Bikers' Breakfast' on the following days:

Tuesday 1st May - Years 3 and 4
Wednesday 2nd May - for Years 5 and 6

On their respective days the children who have cycled are invited to come and have breakfast in school at 8:15 am. In order to attend the breakfast they need to have returned the slip below by Friday 27th April, and cycle to school on their year group's day.

They can decorate their bikes to create a new image. The children can decide how they would like to decorate their bikes using a range of material, such as tinsel, streamers, coloured paper or card etc. They may like to make them bright and colourful or they may wish to choose a particular theme such as an animal or an event. The more fun, imaginative and creative the better! There will be a prize for the best entry. In order to identify who the winning entry belongs to, we ask that you attach a label with your child's name and class to the handlebars. The label can be attached by string.
