The words chosen follow particular spelling rules or patterns, or emphasise a particular suffix or prefix. PE homework will also be given weekly. Make sure you sign to confirm that your child has completed their active homework!

Children will have the right and responsibility, with help from their class teacher to select two or three targets for writing, reading and maths. Their targets are crucial for helping them progress in all areas of the curriculum to ensure that standards across all areas of learning are high.
