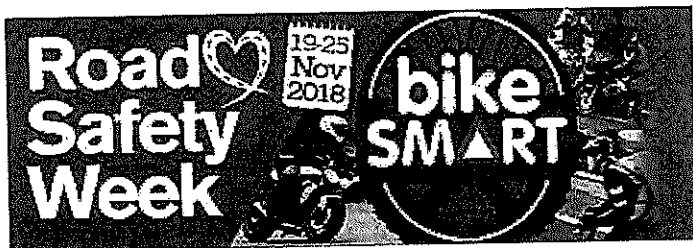


Design a Road Safety Banner

We are inviting pupils aged 4 - 11 from your school to enter this competition by creating a banner design to help raise awareness about road safety.

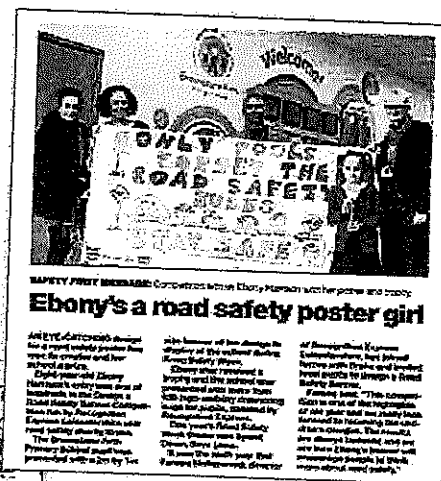
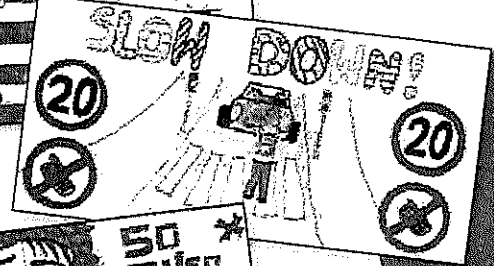
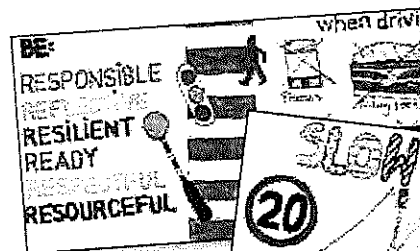

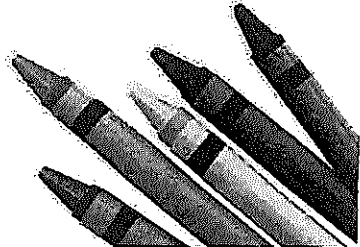
Please note that the deadline for sending entries is **Friday 12th October 2018.**
