As part of our drive to maintain, promote and engage pupil interest in reading, the school is holding Book Week from Monday 4th March – Friday 8th March.

As part of this, we will be celebrating **World Book Day on Thursday 7th March** and on this special day, the children will be able to come to school dressed up as their favourite character from any book. The dressing up possibilities are endless: Oliver Twist, Fantastic Mr Fox, Matilda, Goldilocks, Gruffalo, Elmer the Elephant, Harry Potter etc. Try to get creative by using what you already have at home or you could keep it simple by dressing up all in one colour.

During this week the children will be participating in lots of exciting activities (see timetable), such as:

- Story time with Mrs Hughes at break time

- Masterclass author and illustrator tutorials every lunch time
