

## Year 5 Spellings: Week beginning 27<sup>th</sup> April 2020

To help you learn key spellings and spelling patterns, we will choose 10 words each week and put them in a sentence. Once you have learnt the words, ask an adult to read the sentences out to you (not in order) so that you can spell the word. The adult should read it as below:

3.	later	You can always change your password at a <b>later</b> date.	later
4.	earlier	The guests had arrived <b>earlier</b> than expected and we were unprepared.	earlier
5.	eventually	After a long search, they <b>eventually</b> found the missing jigsaw piece.	eventually
6.	recently	I <b>recently</b> tidied up my Lego bricks and sorted them into different sizes.	recently
7.	previously	The family next door had <b>previously</b> lived in South London.	previously
8.	finally	After a long and tiring journey, we <b>finally</b> arrived home after midnight.	finally
9.	lately	I have had lots of energy <b>lately</b> and have been running every day.	lately
10.	immediately	If we want to avoid the traffic, we should leave <b>immediately</b> .	immediately
11.	pollination	Many species of tree depend on the wind for <b>pollination</b> .	pollination
12.	dispersal	In addition to wind or insect <b>dispersal</b> , seeds can be dispersed by water.	dispersal
13.	germination	The cold and frost of winter helps to stimulate <b>germination</b> .	germination
