Children must arrive and leave school with a responsible adult.

Year 6 Return to school

Hygiene	Each day will begin with a reminder of all hygiene measures that children must observe.
Entering the school	The children will line up outside the school gates, two metres apart. Children must enter via the double gates, usually opened at home time. Only children will be permitted into the school - no parents. Senior Leaders will supervise entry and exit.
Lining up	Children will line up for their groups in their allocated lines, two metres apart (cones to signal). They will be led in by an adult, through the outside classroom doors.
Playtimes	Each group will be allocated a zone in which they can play in. No contact sports are permitted and social distancing guidelines should still be adhered to. It is recommended that children bring in packed lunches (that can be eaten in classrooms/playing zones) and those having school dinners will have a staggered slot. A midday will be on duty near all the toilets, to ensure sanitation/social distancing takes place.
Lunchtimes	
Corridors	The corridors are not to be used other than for bathroom access. Children will be accompanied by an adult.
Toileting	Each group will be allocated a cubicle to use- divided into genders. An adult will supervise them down the corridor. The toilet must be wiped down, by the child, before and after use with a disinfectant wipe. They must use the same toilets at playtime and lunchtime- again- supervised by an adult.
Equipment	Children will be provided with new pencil/pen/ruler/books. This will be theirs for the duration of the summer term. They are not to bring in pencil cases or bags from home.
Tables	Tables will be set out in 'test-style' arrangement to allow for social distancing.
PE kits	Children will not need to bring in PE kits
End of the day	Class teachers will lead the children out into the playground. Ordinary end of day procedure but with social distancing. Children must be collected- they are not to go home alone.
Attendance	Attendance for the Year 6 pupils isn't statutory. However, we do ask that, at the beginning of the week, the parents inform the group teacher which days they intend on sending their children in that week.
Siblings	Only Year 6 pupils are permitted to attend. If they have siblings in Years 3-5 they may only attend if their parents have key worker status. They will be asked to provide a letter to show this.
Learning	Children will continue to follow online learning resources but these will be extended and taught by the teacher.
