
PSHE: Joining in and joining up

PSHE: Joining in and joining up


Looking wider, local government is responsible for a range of services for people in small areas. Examples are social care, schools, housing and waste collection.

Local councils, which is the most common type of local authority, are made up of councillors who are elected by the public (people) in local elections.

Councillors work with local people and partners, such as local businesses and other organisations, to agree and deliver on local priorities.




PSHE: Joining in and joining up

- engage (interact; socialize) with the local community
- work and act on behalf of people in the community
- speak at public meetings
- attend council meetings and workshops
- study plans, proposals, complaints and reports
- work to address issues in the community
- present ideas, debate issues and vote on new policies
