5.	mixture	The cake <b>mixture</b> began to rise when it was put in the oven.	mixture
6.	puncture	While in the bike race, he suffered a <b>puncture</b> which cost him the race.	puncture
7.	sculpture	He made an amazing <b>sculpture</b> using natural materials like rocks, leaves and twigs.	sculpture
8.	signature	My <b>signature</b> has lots of squiggles.	signature
9.	temperature	Yesterday, the <b>temperature</b> outside dropped by 5 degrees Celsius.	temperature
10.	texture	The artist created <b>texture</b> in his drawing by using a clever technique called cross hatching.	texture
