

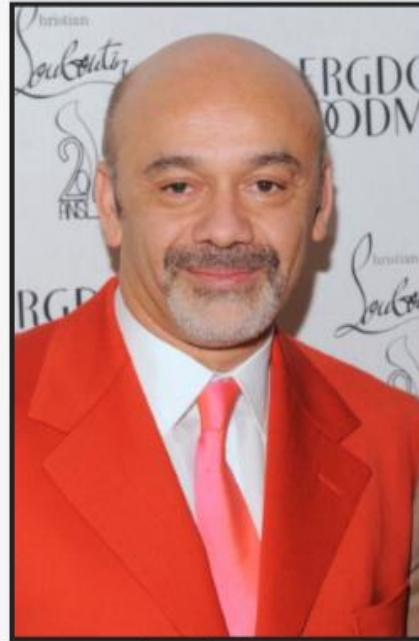
# Art in Fashion

This is Jimmy Choo. He is a Malaysian fashion designer who lives in the UK. He was born in 1948 into a family of shoe makers. Choo is most famous for his range of handmade women's shoes.

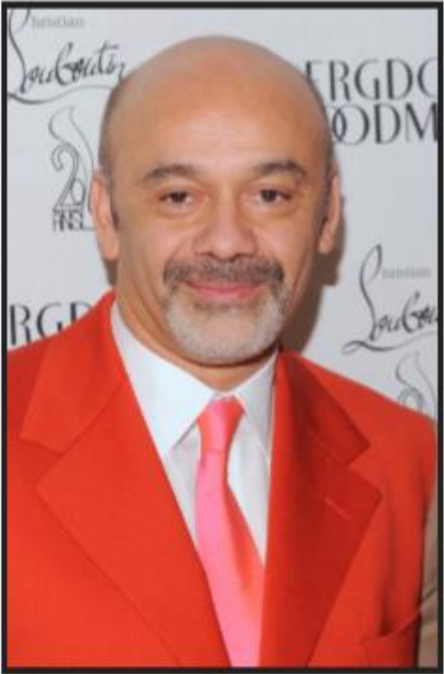




This is Christian Louboutin. He is a French footwear designer. Most of the shoes he designs have shiny red soles. This style feature has become his signature design. He uses exactly the same red for each pair of shoes. Louboutin is credited with helping to bring stilettos back into fashion.

This is Dame Vivienne Westwood. She is a British fashion designer who is credited with bringing punk fashions into the mainstream. She was born in 1941 in England. While Westwood was working as a primary school teacher she made and sold her own jewellery. In the 1970s she became known for developing a punk style. The purple shoes pictured were worn by Naomi Campbell in 1993.

Are there any similarities between these shoes and modern shoes?



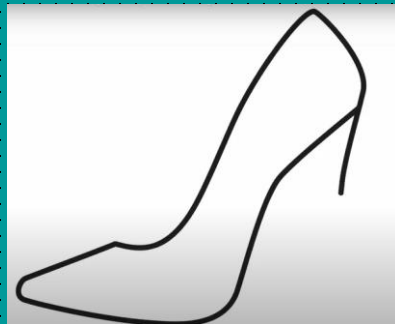
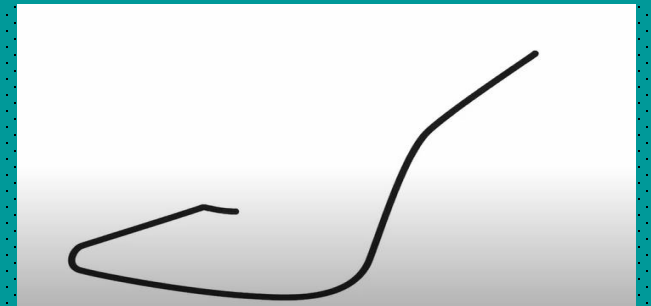
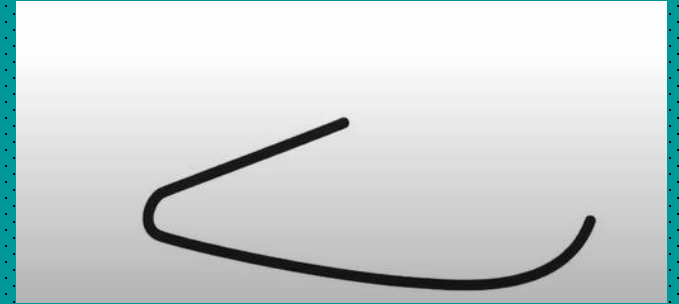
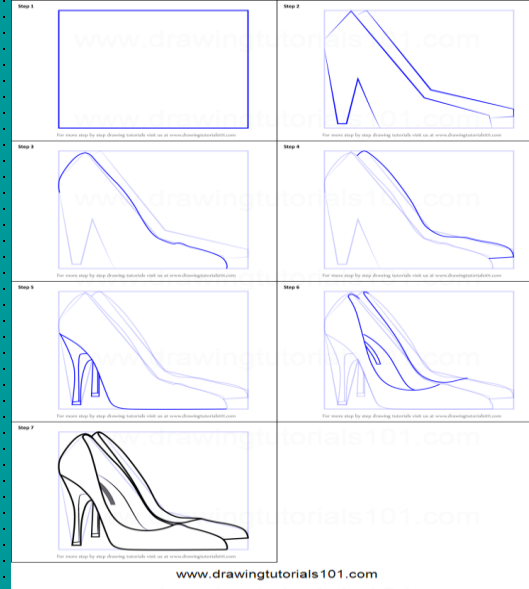
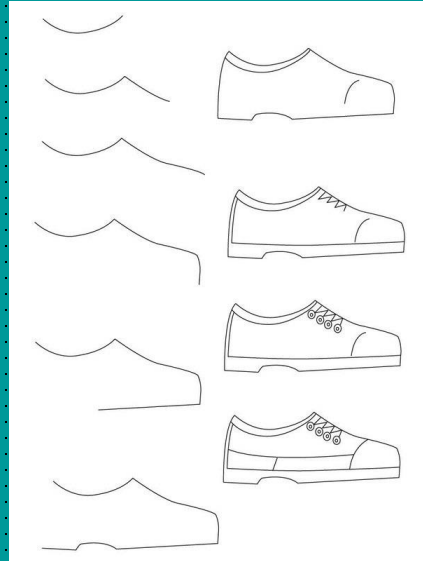
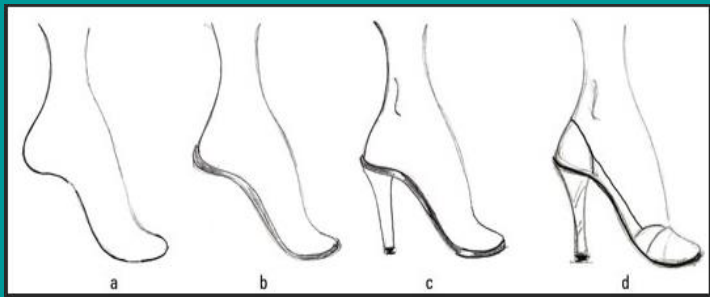
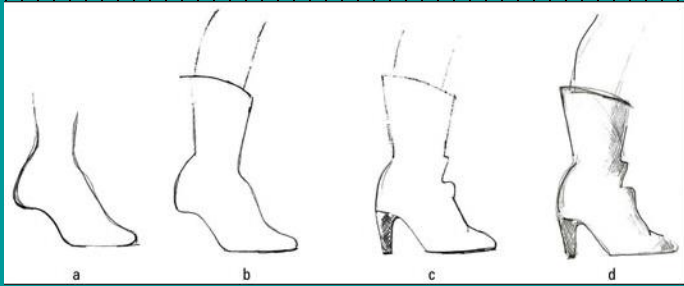
