This week we would like you to write a letter to your teacher, explaining what you have been doing and learning at home. To make it clearer, you need to use paragraphs.

In your letter, each **paragraph** should talk about something different.

For example:

- Paragraph 1 = what you have learnt in your home schooling
- Paragraph 2 = what you have enjoyed doing the most
- Paragraph 3 = what you are looking forward to when you go back to school

Letters also contain **questions** so that the **recipient** (the person receiving the letter) can answer those questions.
