
<u>Planning session</u> Answer the questions in the boxes provided.

Writing Session

You can write from one of the following points of view:

- The mammoth, who has escaped from somewhere and is making his way down this New York City Street
- A tourist, who is spending the day in New York City

Your story needs to show a sudden change in event; so if you are writing as the mammoth, have the first part of the story as a normal day at the zoo and then the escape. If you are writing as the tourist, have the first part of the story as a normal day in the city and then you see the mammoth on the street.

Make sure you include:

- A setting description
- Dialogue to show how characters react to the scene
