Dear Parents, Carers and Children

The summer has seen many changes, to government guidelines, on C-19. One message is unwavering:

REMAIN CAUTIOUS.

It is with this rationale and with our community’s health and safety to the forefront, we have made set out the following guidelines.

Please see below, our reviewed guidelines for the September 2021, school return.

Start and Finish Times

There will no longer be staggered start and finish times to the day and children should be in their class line, by 8:55am. School finishes at 3:30pm. Teachers will meet and greet children (and parents), on the playground or playing field.

Entrance and Exit

Year 3, 4 and 5 will enter and exit through the double gates, on Lord Avenue.

Year 6 will use the double gates, on Stradbroke Grove. This will be subject to ongoing review.

If you have children in both groups, you can use the Lord Avenue entrance for all your children.

Teachers will meet and greet the children (and parents), on the playground or playing field.

Children should be collected from the same place they line up.

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Masks.

Masks are optional for both adults and children. Parents will be required to wear a mask **but only when entering Reception**. Masks will be available in Reception.

Clubs

After school clubs will resume after the October half term holiday. Breakfast club opens as usual on, Thursday 2nd September 2021.

Bubbles.

Children are now able to mix as year group bubbles inside and *not* class bubbles, as before. Outside, all year group bubbles can mix.

Continued Safe Hygiene Practices.

Children will continue to wash their hands at the beginning of the day, after break, before they are taken to eat their lunch and after lunchtime.

We will continue to maintain appropriate cleaning regimes and keep all areas well ventilated.

Additional Points.

Children can bring in school bags. They can also take their reading books and reading record home each day.

Finally...

Year group general meetings, with all parents, will be carried during September and October. Each class will be given a date and time, allowing parents to meet teachers informally. The meeting will last no longer than ten minutes and will include a short presentation, from your child’s teacher. Times and dates will be sent out when children return to school.
