Testing

Please ensure that you test your child the day before they return to school. If you have not done so already, follow a routine of testing your child regularly.

Entrance and Exit

Year 3, 4 and 5 will continue to enter and exit through the double gates, on Lord Avenue. **Year 6** will continue to use the double gates, on Stradbroke Grove. If you have children in both groups, you can use the Lord Avenue entrance for all your children. Teachers will meet and greet the children (and parents), on the playground or playing field. Children should be collected from the same place they line up.

Masks.

Masks are optional for both adults and children. Parents will be required to wear a mask **but only when entering Reception**. Masks will be available in Reception.

Clubs

After school clubs will resume from the week beginning, 10th January 2022. Breakfast club opens as usual on, Thursday 6th January 2022.

Bubbles.

Children will continue to mix as year group bubbles inside and *not* class bubbles, as before. Outside, all year group bubbles can mix.
